

READ: EPHESIANS 4:12-13

Your gifts are not how you become mature. You become mature when you allow other gifts to equip you for the work of service. We often think that our gifting is the main thing that we will be held accountable for, however the truth is, we will be held accountable for all the things that God asks us to do and many of these will require us to learn & receive off other peoples' giftings.

You gift of teaching would benefit from you being mentored by someone who has the gift of mercy. Your gift of leadership would improve if you humbly learnt from someone with the gift of encouragement. The gifts are for all of us to be BUILT UP so we can do what God has asked us to do.

QUESTIONS FOR THE GROUP
