

THE WINDS OF GOD: PART 2

PS BENAIAH

Last connect study we looked at two types of the winds of God (1) The winds of His presence & (2) The winds of change. When God breathes upon us, times of refreshing come.

Just as a southerly change brings a season of relief so the winds of God in our lives bring relief to us. The Bible talks about the breath of God. The Hebrew word is Ruach. The winds of God come upon us for different purposes. Our response is to simply say yes to his breath upon us.

3. The winds of creativity (being used by the spirit)

READ: GENESIS 2:7, PSALM 33:6

When God breathed his breath into the dust to create man, he used the Ruah breathe. When God breathes into our lives, the same Ruach causes us to become alive in him. God used this breath on dirt to create masterpieces! He will often breathe upon us to move creativity for His kingdom.

4. The winds of revival (being transformed by his spirit)

ACTS 2:2, EZEKIEL 37:9

Just as the mighty rushing wind came in Acts 2, so God wants to pour out the winds of revival on us today. He wasn't to transform us by his spirit and bring to life any areas of our hearts that are not consumed by him.
